### MISSING/REPLACEMENT BALLOT INFORMATION

The NMB-Union Representation Election deadline for a replacement ballot is less than 1 month away. The NMB will not accept ANY requests for new ballots after **February 5, 2026**. AMFA recommends that members send new ballot requests, no later than **January 29, 2026**.

If you have not received your ballot by now, you will need to send either a letter or the form on page 2 of this update. All requests need to be sent to the NMB immediately! You will need to “wet” sign the letter. USPS Certified or First-Class mail is a great option for shipping that provides tracking information. The Union Representation election is being conducted by the NMB and mail ballots are the only option. If you need any further assistance, then reach out to your respective ALR IMMEDIATELY!

#### NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES IN THE CRAFT OR CLASS

**Federal law prohibits knowingly and willfully making materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations in any matter within the jurisdiction of the United States Government. 18 U.S.C. § 1001. This includes use of another voter's ballot and voting materials. To maintain the confidentiality and integrity of the voting process, do not share your ballot or voting materials with anyone. Evidence of breaches of the confidentiality or integrity of the voting process, including “voting parties” may result in a Board finding of election interference. If you do not receive your Official Ballot by **December 23, 2025**, you may contact the National Mediation Board to request a duplicate ballot. Your request must be in writing and signed by you. The request must be in an individual envelope. No group requests are accepted. Requests by telephone, email, or facsimile are not accepted.
