AMFA WINS NMB UNION ELECTION

It is with great honor and pride to announce that the Aircraft Mechanics Fraternal Association (AMFA) has won the Union Representation Election for the Mechanics and Related employees at Alaska/Hawaiian Airlines. The National Mediation Board (NMB), Union Representation Election ballots were tallied on February 24, 2026. We expect the NMB to certify the election/results by end of day **February 25, 2026**. There is a 7-day protest period that can be initiated by the IAM. Election protests will not stop the certification of the election by the NMB, nor will any protest stop AMFA from representing all its members from day 1.

Upon the certification of the Union Representation Election, AMFA will begin to organize the Hawaiian Airlines members with Integrated Seniority List (ISL) & Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement (JCBA) committees. These committees will take part in the ISL and JCBA negotiations to bring the merging Alaska and Hawaiian Mechanics & Related work groups together under AMFA CBAs. AMFA will begin Area and Shop Representative elections for the new Hawaiian Airlines members.
